Summary

Everyone wants to have a good life. But culture's idea of a good life is very different than God's idea of a good life. Culture says its all about what I can get and the pleasure I can have. It's all about me. But God says its all about Him; and how he can sanctify those who love him, healing them in their brokenness and then using them to heal the brokenness of culture. But if we're holding on to sin in our lives it's much more difficult to bring glory to God. We need to be vulnerable with God and other believers in order to overcome sin and be used for God's grand purpose.
