Diving deeper

Read 2 Chronicles 20:1-23 We see in these verse the Israelites singing, not just for fun, but to wage war. Have you ever thought about singing in this way? Spend some time processing how music can help us reevaluate our situations, and the "battles" we might be fighting right now. In the New Testament Paul and Silas saw literal walls crumble because of singing and the power of God, where might you have walls that need singing and the power of God?
