Episode 2 summary

Discussion questions

Q1 Think back to when you were younger. Is there a piece of media that had uncomfortable or concerning messages? Did you passively accept it or realize it was a little... off?

Q2 In the same vein as the first question, what was a piece of media that opened up your mind? Maybe it revealed a different side to the world or helped you understand a reality you weren't aware of.

O3 The tension between art damaging and empowering artists is a constant tension. Think of a music artist that you either thought less of or more of because of the contents of their music.

Diving deeper

Read **Leviticus 19:33-34** and then read **Luke 10:25-37**. Luke records the example of the "Good Samaritan." Many look at Jesus's response to the lawyer as Jesus expanding the definition of neighbor to include all people. After reading both examples of "The Golden Rule" do you think Jesus was expanding on Leviticus or just reinforcing what was already there? Spend some time discussing this with someone!
